


Family Bible Church Neighborhood VBS

Information for families without a Gift Bag (on both sides)



Exodus 15: 2-3, 13

The Lord is my strength and my defense. He is my God, and I will praise him.
The Lord is a warrior; the Lord is his name.

In your unfailing love you will lead the people you have redeemed.
In your strength, you will guide them to your holy dwelling.

Invite kids to your house to join you for VBS this week or just enjoy VBS at home with your kids. Watch the videos at whatever times (or days, or weeks!) work well for you. (Your kids can watch parts of it – or all of it! – again and again!)

“What do I need to participate since I don’t have a Gift Bag?”

Snack Materials:

Day 1: 1 Graham Cracker, blue frosting, candy fish “sprinkles”

Day 2: Nilla Wafer cookies, 1 Peep, gummy worm(s)

Day 3: Large pretzel rod, multi-colored Twizzlers Pull & Peel Twisted

Day 4: Brownie, thin pretzel sticks, orange frosting, mini marshmallow

Day 5: 2 Milano cookies, chocolate frosting

Craft Materials: (Days 1, 3, & 4 will be different crafts than seen on the video)

Game Activities:

Day 1: a sheet, blanket, or large beach towel (for each child)

Day 3: a balloon (can use one from their gift bag) for each child and a large box, basket, or hamper for each group.


Special Lollipops: 5 different kinds to have a different one each day

The videos include 5 days of VBS: each with Opening Assembly (with singing, dancing, our skit, and lesson pitch); 4 stations (Bible, Snack & Science, Activities, and Craft); and Closing Assembly (with more singing and dancing, lesson review, and memory verse). Total video time per day is about 45 minutes, offering breaks throughout to create (and eat!) the snack, make the craft, and play the activity.

“What do I do?” Someone needs to be available to assist if needed during the craft and snack preparation. They’ll love it if you participate with them the entire time but do what you can do. At the end of each day’s VBS, ask your child to recite the day’s memory verse to you (you can help them if they need help!) and then allow them to choose a special “memory verse” lollipop.

Daily Takeaways

Monday: God is with us, so trust God!

Tuesday: God gives us what we need, so trust God!

Wednesday: God gives us strength, so trust God!

Thursday: God saves us, so trust God!

Friday: God guides us, so trust God!

Snack Questions

Monday: If you only had 5 minutes to pack and leave your home forever,
what would you take?

Tuesday: What would you call the "whatsit"?

Wednesday: Is there something for which you need strength?

What can you do if you need more strength?

Thursday: Can you remember a time when God gave you what you needed?

What was it?

Friday: Read the 10 Commandments together and talk about ways in which
you do these things well and ways in which you could do these things better.

10 Commandments:

- You shall have no other gods before me
- You shall not make for yourself an idol
- You shall not misuse the name of the LORD your God
- Remember the Sabbath day by keeping it holy
- Honor your father and your mother
- You shall not murder
- You shall not commit adultery
- You shall not steal
- You shall not give false testimony against your neighbor
- You shall not covet
