**ANNUAL BUSINESS MEETING BY-LAW VOTE**

We are holding a vote of the membership to change the Constitution By-Laws concerning the Annual Congregational Meeting. The current Constitutional By-Laws under "Article VII: Meetings; sectional 1. Annual Business Meeting," states, "The annual business meeting of the church shall be held during the month of June each year."

We, the Elders, are proposing this section be changed to read,


"An annual business meeting of the church membership shall be held each year. The Elder Board will give membership four (4) weeks notice prior to each annual meeting. No longer than 12 months may pass between annual business meetings without proper notification from the Elder Board."

How to vote (members only)?

1. You should have received an electronic form by email on 6/18.
2. If you have an email on file, but did not receive an email, please call the office to cast your vote or to receive a ballot by mail.
3. If you do not have an email on file with us you should have received a mailed ballot to return by **July 12<sup>th</sup>**.

**GLOBAL PARTNERS CORNER**

FBC Global Partner Pregnancy Care Clinic (PCC) has been serving Whidbey Island and the surrounding communities since 1986. They exist to provide free & confidential pregnancy alternatives to individuals and families faced with unplanned pregnancy situations, as well as parenting support and material assistance.



PCC faces challenging times with the COVID-19 shutdown of fundraising events which provide the funds necessary to provide these free services. In conjunction with the Virtual Baby Bottle Boomerang Fundraiser in June, the Global Partners Council (GPC) recommended a \$1,000 special gift be sent from the COVID-19 Benevolence Fund to help mitigate the budget deficit this year. Last week, an additional \$500 came in from Designated Congregational Giving for this project which the GPC sent to PCC as well. Many FBC people are actively involved in the staffing, administration, and volunteers at PCC.
