GLOBAL PARTNERS CORNER



Last month, at the recommendation of the Global Partner Council, a \$500 special gift was sent from the FBC COVID-19 Benevolence Fund to the agency, **Commission to Every Nation**, to assist poor pastors in the Philippines, who face serious difficulties because of the pandemic. As is common in rural areas around the world, many poor pastors in the Philippines receive only \$30-50 monthly from their small country churches' offering. Since churches are not allowed to meet (because of the country wide lockdown), they have no funds at all. **No funds; therefore, NO FOOD!!** This gift will go to a fund to help provide food to needy pastors and their families during this crisis. This is the same agency that the FBC congregation has collected Christian books & Bibles for in the past to send to Filipino pastors to assist in their ministries.
