This remarkable woman, Marjorie Prince, spawned a legacy that saw not only her daughter Ann and husband Doug go to the mission field, but granddaughter Janelle and husband also serving with Cru in the Middle East, plus her (soon to be married) older, multi-lingual granddaughter Jocelyn travels around the world with a Cru offshoot called StoryRunners (Orlando, FL). Of the 7,000 some languages in the world, more than half have no known Scripture. StoryRunners enables people in these unreached language groups hear the Gospel in a way they understand: oral Bible storytelling.
