Last year and again this year, we have focused on local short term mission trips, specifically at the YD facilities in WA & Idaho. As a result, we have rebranded our MMBT acronym to stand for **Men's Ministry Build Trip**.

This year we will return to YD-Stonewater Ranch in Plain, WA to help with another build project. We will be building a tent platform for their Ice wall facility. Trip dates are Thursday, June 10 – Monday, June 14. The trip will conclude with a rafting and rock-climbing excursion. We can take up to 12 men/teens. There is no cost for this trip aside from your transportation costs to get there. The Men's Ministry will provide the food and YD will provide lodging. No building experience necessary; just willingness to work hard and a heart to serve.
