This Fall, FBC sent GP Steppin' Out Missions (SOM) a \$500 special gift to assist their efforts for the cleanup of Hurricane Ida, that hit Louisiana late August-early September this year. SOM is a designated partner for Samaritan's Purse (SP) when any major disaster hits the USA and SP is in need of heavy equipment/ operators,



chainsaw crews, and debris cleanup, etc. Headquartered in Sugarcreek, Ohio, SOM works with volunteers from around the country that participate in this type of outreach which involved two weeks in the Metairie area on the south side of Lake Pontchartrain, northeast of New Orleans. Major tree damage in the neighborhoods there required skidders, miniexcavators, and man-lifts to assist chainsaw crews in accomplishing their tasks. All these "toys" come with fuel, tire, maintenance, transportation, and insurance costs which come out of SOM's general budget. Thank you for allowing SOM to be the hands/feet of Christ.
