





## **2 Peter** by Kay Arthur

**\*Precept Upon Precept and In & Out options for two levels of inductive study**



Peter was a fisherman who became the leader of The Way. He sat in Jesus' inner circle. He witnessed miracles and multitudes. Peter denied Christ but then became the proclaimer of the Gospel at Pentecost. He ran to the tomb but left confused. He was inspired to pen his letters for believers the generation after that empty tomb. Letters God meant for the ages, letters for you and me. In Peter's second epistle he focuses on internal opposition caused by false teachers whose "destructive heresies" can seduce believers into error and immorality. This book stresses the need for growth in the grace and knowledge of Jesus Christ. The best antidote for error is a mature understanding of the truth. Seek words of eternal life with this shepherd of God's people.




