



Ezra & Haggai-Israel lost their nationhood when God disciplined them for their idolatry and disobedience to the Law. His people were taken into exile but God would remember His covenant and bring His people back to the land of the patriarch's promise. Experience what it's like when God places His hand on the lives of His people in Ezra and Haggai to prove He is the promise-keeping God.

Esther-God also reveals Himself as the great promise keeper in Esther. In Mordecai's words to Esther: "If you remain silent at this time, relief and deliverance will arise for the Jews from another place and you and your father's house will perish" (Esther 4:14). Mordecai's words reflected his faith that God would honor His eternal covenant with Abraham and David. God's people would not be extinguished out of existence because Messiah was to come through the Jewish people. Esther attained royalty for "such a time as this". She allowed God to use her in difficult situations. Are you willing to do the same?


