



Mark and Lisa DeNeui were appointed with WorldVenture in 1991 as church planters to Belgium, a country with very few believers and churches. They planted a church in western Brussels, and as the church became more established, Mark began training church leaders at the Brussels Bible Institute (Institut Biblique de Bruxelles).

As Mark's teaching experience and passion for training church leaders grew, so did Lisa's ministry of discipleship and Bible study teaching. In order to open the most doors possible for future ministry, the DeNeuis, with WorldVenture's support, moved to Aberdeen, Scotland in 2004, where Mark completed a doctorate in New Testament, focusing on the church.

In 2008 the DeNeuis moved to the Alsace region of France. Mark taught church leaders as a New Testament Professor at the Institut Biblique de Bruxelles and the *Institut Biblique de Genève*. After a home assignment, the DeNeui's relocated one hour north, to the city of Strasbourg, France where they joined a church-planting network. One of the church plants is incorporating a community centre, focused on outreach to specific people groups and the refugee community. Lisa is looking forward to participating in this ministry. Mark will continue to teach in the Bible Institutes as well as training leaders in the church-planting network.

Mark and Lisa are also one of five couples who make up WorldVenture's Europe/Middle-East Team (EMT). This team oversees WorldVenture's missionaries in Europe and the Middle East. The DeNeuis are specifically in charge of personnel in Netherlands, England, Germany, Poland and the Czech Republic.

Mark and Lisa have three adult children: Luc, Alison and Anne.
